Some advice

The end of July and month of August is the traditional
time for graveyard ceremonies. Unfortunately thieves
target parked cars of persons attending the ceremonies
Ensure your car is locked with all windows closed.

1. Remove any valuables and place in the boot before
you set out to attend the ceremonies - better still
remove items and leave at home if possible
2. Thieves are targeting ladies handbags, cameras,
binoculars & sat navs, basically any item that can
be quickly sold on.
3. Parked cars will be checked discreetly by the thieves
who will return when the ceremonies are proceeding.
4. Persons acting suspiciously i.e. loitering in the area
should be kept under observation and Gardaí
contacted

Day of Prayer for Marriage and Family Life

Friday 11th July

Theme: **Vocation of the Single Person**

- We generally think about vocation in terms of
priesthood and religious life - and sometimes in
terms of marriage. Very seldom do we consider
the vocation of the single person.
- For us as Christians there is only one vocation
and this comes through Baptism. **The vocation
of each of us is to be a disciple of Christ**
- This is then expressed and lived differently
because of the different circumstances of our
lives.
- Some people live this vocation in Marriage,
some in Priesthood and Religious life.
- Single people live as disciples of Christ in the
ordinary circumstances of their lives, using their
gifts to bring peace and healing and hope to
those around them.
- Newly Baptised babies and children bring joy
and hope to everyone.
- Young people have so much to bring to other
young people.
- And older single people have gifts that are badly
needed in today's world. They are often the
people who look after a sick or elderly parent or
sibling. Unfortunately they can sometimes be
taken for granted by the rest of the family.
