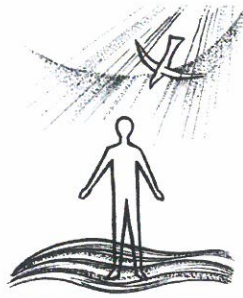

others in a hotel or other such place in a civil
