Saturday 11th August

Theme: Vocation of the Single Person

Some Thoughts:

- We generally think about vocation in terms of
priesthood and religious life – and sometimes
in terms of marriage. Very seldom do we
consider the vocation of the single person.
- For us as Christians there is only one vocation
and this comes through Baptism. The vocation
of each of us is to be a disciple of Christ.
- This is then expressed and lived differently
because of the different circumstances of our
lives.
- Some people live this vocation in marriage, by
living as a disciple of Christ in the relationship
with one other person as a Sacrament in service
of their children and the world in which they
live.
- Some people live this vocation in Priesthood
by living as a disciple of Christ in the fraternity
of the priesthood in union with the Bishop for
the service of the parishes of their Diocese and
the Universal Church.
- Single people live as disciples of Christ in the
ordinary circumstances of their lives, using
their gifts to bring peace and healing and hope
to those around them.
- Good models for single people are Martha,
whose feast day is July 29th, her sister Mary
and their brother Lazarus. Jesus was a frequent
visitor to their home and often received
hospitality at their table.
