as we light the candle (s) of this wreath.
May the wreath and its light be a sign of
Christ's promise to bring us salvation.
May he come quickly and not delay.
We ask this through Christ our Lord. **Amen**

period of expectant waiting and preparation for the
celebration of the Nativity of Jesus, the period
immediately before Christmas

Jesse Tree

Jesse was the father of the great King David of the Old
Testament. He is often looked upon as the first person
in the genealogy of Jesus. The Jesse Tree is named
after Isaiah 11:1: "A shoot will spring forth from the
stump of Jesse, and a branch out of his roots." In other
words, the Jesse Tree is Jesus' family tree. The
ornaments on the Jesse Tree are meant to connect
Advent and Christmas the thousands of years of
history covered in the Old Testament.
