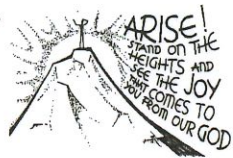

**Theme: A child is born for us
The Joy of Love – Pope Francis**

Every family should look to the icon of the Holy
Family of Nazareth. Its daily life had its share of

Herod's implacable violence..... Like the Magi,
our families are invited to contemplate the Child and
his Mother, to bow down and worship him. Like Mary
they are asked to face their family's challenge with
courage and serenity, in good times and in bad, and to

- ◆ **First Friday Communion Calls:** Priests will not be visiting homes (going from house to house) on First Fridays for the time being. They will make one or two calls per day in the next few weeks with Communion and Anointing for Christmas. Should you wish to have a visit at any other time, please feel free to call us at any time.
- ◆ **Choirs:** *Kilbarron Parish Choir* (formerly known as Resurrection Choir) to resume practise. **Kilbarron Folk Group** will sing at two Masses per month. **Childrens' Choir** to be deferred to New Year. (All choir members to observe social distancing and to wear masks)
- ◆ **Carol Service:** Wednesday, 15th Dec. at 7pm
- ◆ **Christmas Masses:** **Friday 24th** 9.30am, 6pm & 8pm, **Saturday Christmas Day** 9am & 11am; 10am in Cashelard
- ◆ **Recent HSE Guidelines: Funerals & Wakes** **Social Distancing, Sanitising & Wearing of Mask** to be strictly observed at all times in wake houses and at funerals. NO shaking of hands or hugging. Social distancing to be observed and masks to be worn in Guards of Honour and in the Graveyard.
